

Tennessee Saddle Club Association (TSCA)

POLICY

Revised 2013

1. **Open Shows:** Member Clubs holding Open Shows must use TSCA rules in all events that are covered by state rules. Where events are not governed by State rules, an exception must be stated on all show bills.
2. **Trophies and Awards:** When the participants of a trophy class decreases to 14 riders, based on figures from the previous year, the designated number of trophies to be awarded will decrease to five. (Revised 2012).
3. **Entry Forms:** Entry forms and point books must be turned in or mailed, (Postmarked) to the Show Coordinator by August 15th. (Revised 2013).
4. **Entry Fees:** Entry Fees and advance ticket sales are to be paid at the time entry cards are turned in. Entry fees will go to the designated State Show Personnel and advance ticket sales will go to the Show Ticket Secretary. (If extra tickets are needed you may contact the Show Ticket Secretary until day of show.)
5. **Equipment:** Member clubs must use uniform properties (i.e.: barrels, poles, etc.) and related equipment
6. **Vendors and Services:** The TSCA shall handle all booths/spaces related to concessions and vendors to better serve the members of the Association. Net profit will go to the Host Club. (Revised 2013)
7. **Requirements for the Host Club at the State Show:** (if no Host Club, the TSCA will act as the Host Club):
 - a. Must furnish all properties satisfying TSCA specifications for such properties.
 - b. Must supply two (2) tractors that are a minimum of 50 horsepower each for working the arena.
 - c. Maintain dust control on the entire arena area
 - d. Collect all fees for camping, stalls, etc. Checks to be made out to "TSCA" and must be paid.
 - e. Must have a 4 in 1 or equivalent equipment to work the arena.
 - f. Set up the arena chute to meet TSCA specifications.
 - g. Set up the arena per TSCA specifications.
 - h. Must bring Trophies to arena
 - i. Must work the arena before each class and at designated intervals during speed events.
8. **New Clubs:** All new clubs must be verified before yearly dues will be accepted.
9. **Point and Open Shows:** Saddle Clubs are prohibited from holding a club (point) show on the same day as an Open or Jackpot Show. (Revised 2012). **All saddle clubs are prohibited from holding any point shows in the State Show Arena.**
10. **Meetings and Results:** Meeting minutes will be posted on the website after the February meeting. Final State Show results will be posted soon after the conclusion of the State Show.
11. **Adding Classes:** Any new classes that are added to the TSCA State show will be worked by the club that made the motion to add the class. The new class will also be added to the end of that day's events, exception would be additions to the western classes. Addition to western classes will be added to the end of the western events held inside of the arena.
12. **Class Participation:** If the number of participants (not entries) is ten (10) or less in a class, from the previous year, the class will be eliminated the following year. (Revised 2012).
